
We are committed to fairly and sustainably manufacturing corporate clothing.



Our fair & sustainable tailoring

95% of the polyester used in our collections is made from recycled plastic bottles. All our garments are then crafted in our factories using renewable energy.

That means by wearing Clubclass Corporate Clothing you are preventing plastic bottles reaching our oceans and landfill.

Our warehouse holds 150,000 suits. 95% of our collections use recycled polyester. That's 6,412,500 plastic bottles.




Our core cloth mill is attached to the highest standard of compliance within Oeko-Tex (STEP). We are also Gold Wrap, Sedex and GRS approved.

We don't use agencies to manufacture our tailoring. We don't use factories that we haven't meticulously checked. We know who makes our clothing and we also expect the same from the partners we work with from the fabric mills to the button suppliers.

We have our own staff checking the standards in the factories, we also subscribe to SMETA ethical audit compliance.

Our supply chain is industry leading in terms of compliance, sustainability and welfare so you can feel assured that, at Clubclass, we employ only the highest practices.

CLUBCIASS

All of the board used in the production of Clubclass cartons is made from at least 90% recycled fibres and 100% of the carton can be recycled again – they're also fully biodegradable. Any new material used comes from managed softwood forests that are certified as sustainable.





Sugarcane packaging

Our skirts and trousers are carefully folded and packaged in carbon negative packaging. The packaging is produced in the UK using a thermoplastic resin made from sugarcane which is cultivated responsibly. The packaging is 100% renewable, 100% recyclable and 100% sustainable.

Less Plastic Less Waste

We have reduced the use of hangers reducing waste. By making this change we have also reduced the weight reducing pollution during transportation.

The Lights

Our lights are on motion sensors to preserve energy within the building. Clubclass HQ is fuelled by the solar panels on the roof's building.

Planting Trees

We have planted trees around the office and warehouse to encourage wildlife and to lock up more carbon.

Clubclass Cars

A number of company cars have been updated to be low emission hybrids or electrical vehicles. We have also installed an electrical charging point.

Our Building

Our building is only 3 years old and is built to the highest EU environmental standards. Solar panels are fitted to the roof to supply our electricity and the walls are insulated to the highest standard to ensure energy efficiency throughout the building.
