

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
WE'RE ON A JOURNEY TO A MORE SUSTAINABLE FUTURE...

We continually look at options, including partnering with recycling experts (Avena, SecureBrand and United Shoe), as well as working with companies such as Wilcox and 3Rs to reuse old or redundant products.

Sustainability is a company-wide ethos, the whole team are involved in our quarterly sustainability initiative. Each quarter employees recommend an area for improvement, which is then adopted by the whole business.



We pro-actively involve our staff in idea generation to achieve the Sustainability Targets of the organisation. Our supply partners form a key part of our business and we hold their commitment to sustainability and CSR as imperative.

All new suppliers are subjected to a thorough evaluation process prior to becoming a partner. We ensure that they demonstrate and maintain standards which either match or exceed our expectations. An element of this evaluation process includes a factory visit, or audit. Ongoing relationships are monitored with regular supplier audits, to ensure standards are maintained throughout the business relationship.



With CLUBCLASS Corporate clothing, it is good to know that style and sustainability go hand in hand. Here we highlight 3 of the many commitments Clubclass has made to a better future:

95% POLYESTER USED IS FROM RECYCLED BOTTLES. By wearing Clubclass Corporate Clothing you are preventing plastic bottles reaching our oceans and landfill! Just one suit uses 45 bottles, and a team of 15 wearing Clubclass tailoring will stop 675 plastic bottles from polluting our planet.

KNOW WHO MAKES THE CLOTHING. Clubclass have their own staff checking the factory standards, and also subscribe to SMETA ethical audit compliance. Their supply chain is industry leading in terms of compliance, sustainability and welfare.

PACKAGING INNOVATION & MATERIALS. Clubclass biodegradable cartons are made from at least 90% recycled fibres and 100% of the carton can be recycled again! Clothes are carefully folded and packaged in carbon negative 'sugar-cane' packaging produced in the UK - 100% renewable, recyclable and sustainable!





Did you know 57% of all garments produced worldwide end up in landfill? With the textile industry being one of the most damaging industries to the environment, ØRN are determined to make a difference.

INTRODUCING SUSTAINABLE FABRICS. ØRN create a lot of their garments from sustainable fabrics, and incorporate recycled polyester and cotton where possible.



PACKAGING

As well as suppliers using alternative and recycled materials in their packaging (e.g. Clubclass renewable source sugar-cane bags), we also give a lot of thought to the packaging that goes through our doors at HeathBrook. 40% of the cardboard boxes we use are reused from goods in, and our plastic packaging is made from 100% recycled materials.

SOURCING LOCAL

Where possible, we make an effort to use local suppliers and manufacturing, cutting down on travel emissions, and supporting local economy by 'buying British'. These relationships have especially proved beneficial since the pandemic, and offer a stronger and more sustainable supply chain.

Our in-house production and finishing facility is in Reading, and we are pleased to have a key safety supplier JSP manufacturing in Oxford. Knitwear and short-run garments are also manufactured in the UK.



COMBINING DELIVERIES

We encourage customers to place fewer orders less often, to reduce carbon emissions. That's also why we hold stock of many of our most popular items from suppliers, so we can receive in bulk and send out complete orders in one shipment where possible.

Some of delivery services we use are also swapping over to electric powered fleets, another exciting advance towards a greener future!



THE PRODUCTS THEMSELVES (ECO-FRIENDLY)


Many of our products are selected for their innovation, and eco-friendly properties. Garments made from bamboo fibre (LEO Workwear), jackets that are made from recycled plastic bottles (Orn, LEO, Regatta, Clubclass), and 100% cotton or sustainably produced clothing. Even some of our embroidery threads are made form recycled plastic!



When you give staff a great quality and correct uniform, they'll feel a sense of belonging, and feel more comfortable and confident. Aspects such as the garment fit, modesty, or the protection it offers all play a huge part in the enjoyment of a job - and it therefore stands to reason you'll improve staff retention and maximise their working potential.

This in turn means less changes of uniform, as staff are likely to wear the clothes for longer.

HOW RIGHT CHOICES NOW CAN SAVE MONEY & THE PLANET

At HeathBrook, we believe an investment into a quality garment can not only pay for itself many times over with longevity and endurance (meaning less uniform wastage ending up in landfill), but it can also encourage staff to care for it more than an ill-fitting or low quality garment.

The bottom line? Happier staff, savings in your pocket, and less waste in landfill.

UNIFORM SECURITY & RECYCLING

We understand the challenges of handling old uniforms, from security through to sustainability, and have set up solutions using selected specialist partners. Our partners provide a disposal service by collecting garments and footwear from dedicated recycling bins placed in each depot. These garments are then processed and turned into insulation for construction.

AVENA RECYCLING

One such partner is Avena, the leading recycling company, who manage the whole recycling process including shredding uniforms to prevent any fraudulent use of uniforms post-use. As a leader in secure shredding and recycling of corporate branded clothing, they have spent the last seven years creating a ZERO to landfill solution for textile waste. They provide secure destruction for organisations who are concerned to protect their brand, alongside meeting the corporate and ethical responsibilities, which we face globally for the protection of our environment.

STEP 1

All textiles are shredded at a secure Avena site

STEP 2

Shredded textiles are transported to a recycling partner

STEP 3

The fibres are compressed together into bales

STEP 4

Then reused as floor and desk partition screens, and cement truck protection

UNITED SHOE

Similarly, United Shoe, another partner collects used footwear, collected in bins from depots to dispatch to developing countries who have high levels of poverty, both fulfilling a CSR obligation and removing the need for landfill.

JSP HARD HATS

JSP, local supplier of PPE, have recently worked recently to combat the millions of hard hats that end up in landfill each year. They've founded and promoted the National Hard Hat Recycling Scheme which diverts safety helmets into a dedicated waste processing facility, and ensures all hard hat waste is fully recycled!
